



How Far Your BABY HAS DEVELOPED At 30th Week Of Gestation?



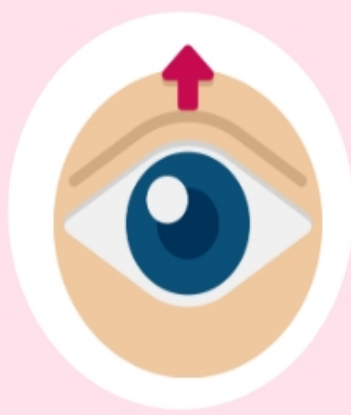
Brain tissues are developing and wrinkling for more brain cells.
