

HOW TO HELP A BABY WHO IS UNRESPONSIVE AFTER A HEAD INJURY?

Hold them lying on their side and tilt their head backward. Tilting the head opens up the airway. Do this for no longer than ten seconds.



Check their breathing. If they are breathing, their chest will move, and you will feel their breaths.



Support their head and raise them, while on their side, allowing their tongue to fall forward and fluid (if any) to drain out.



Continue talking to the baby and reassuring them. Keep the head tilted.



Call an ambulance. While making the call, cradle the baby in your arms or put them on their side.
