



Read the safety precautions provided by the manufacturer.

Seek advice from your doctor before using the brush if you have a skin condition.





Never use it near flammable objects, including cosmetics such as nail polish removers.

Do not use the brush with water warmer than 40 degrees Celsius.





Clean the silicone brush after each use to eliminate grease residue.

Store the brush in a dry, cool, and shaded place to protect the battery.





Fully charge the brush every two months, even during periods of non-use.

Avoid sharing the brush with others to reduce the risk of skin infections.
