


CONDITIONS THAT MAY AFFECT PERIOD AFTER

CONDITIONS THAT MAKE PERIOD WORSE

- Structural defects, such as submucosal fibroids and polyps
- Adenomyosis, a condition where the tissue from the uterine lining grows into the uterus wall, enlarging the uterus





RARE CONDITIONS THAT CAUSE LIGHTER OR NO PERIODS

 Sheehan's syndrome, maternal hypopituitarism caused by excessive blood loss during or after delivery



 Asherman's syndrome, scar tissue formation in the uterine cavity, which often happens after uterus surgery
