



Features Of A Typical Organic Cow Milk Baby Formula

The milk is sourced from primarily grass-fed or pasture-raised cows.



The cows graze on pastures free of synthetic fertilizers and pesticides.

The cow's feed is not supplemented with manure and urea.



The cows are not fed genetically modified (G.M.O.) grains.

The cows are not given synthetic hormones for rapid growth.



Certain synthetic medications, such as antibiotics, are rarely used to treat cow illnesses.
