Type



For delicate baby clothes or coats, opt for a velvet hanger.

Pick a hanger with clips for jeans or skirts.



For regular clothes, you may rely on a traditional baby cloth hanger.

Shape



Flat hangers are suitable for everyday clothes, and they occupy minimal space in the closet.

Curved hangers are ideal for coats and dresses, as they mimic the shoulders.

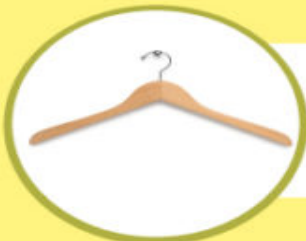


Material



Select stainless steel to keep the hangers rust-free and clothes stain-free.

Opt for odor-free plastic hangers to prevent the spreading of plastic smell to clothes.



Choose splint-free wooden hangers with burr-free edges.

Size

Select a 10- to 11-inch hanger for infant clothes.



Weight



Ensure the hanger you pick can bear the weight of the baby's clothes, as thin and fragile hangers may eventually break.
