He was born around 1341 B.C.E.

Tutankhamun was a well-known ruler who belonged to the powerful royal house (pharaoh) of ancient Egypt.

His tomb was discovered in 1922 by archaeologist Howard Carter.



He was nicknamed the "Boy King" for ascending the throne at the young age of 9.

He died between 18 and 19, possibly due to infection or malaria.



His body was preserved as a mummy in Egypt for thousands of years.
