



Wow Facts For Your Child About Christ The Redeemer

The construction of the statue began in 1922 and was completed in 1931.



Every year, almost two million national and international tourists visit "Christ the Redeemer."



The statue can withstand wind speeds of up to 250kmph (155mph).



It is the largest Art Deco-style (straight lines and simple shapes) structure in the world.



Every night, roughly 300 energy-efficient LED lights are used to illuminate it.



At the statue's base, there is a chapel that was built in 2006.



Before the escalator was installed in 2002, tourists had to ascend 200 steps to get to the statue.
