Age-appropriate

Check the manufacturer's age recommendations before buying. A set designed for older children may be complicated for younger children.

Tutorials

Written or visual tutorials can help your child understand the magic tricks easily, especially if they are beginners.



Skill level

Beginners may pick kits with simple tricks. Experienced users may opt for kits with advanced and complex techniques.



Accessories

Kits with additional accessories allows your child to practice and entertain for hours, expanding their creativity.

Carrying case

A kit with a carrying case allows you to store and take the kit safely while traveling.



Safety

Ensure the kit is made of child-safe materials and does not pose a choking hazard.
