Sandifer Syndrome

The symptoms of Sandifer syndrome resemble those seen in seizures, infant torticollis, infantile spasms, and paroxysmal dystonia.



Symptoms of Sandifer syndrome similar to other conditions

- Sudden arching of the back, head, and legs
- Repeated rotation of the neck
- Tilting of the head
- Involuntary upward movement of the eyes
- Head nodding

Challenges babies may face due to these symptoms



- Unnecessary testing that may be expensive
- Unnecessary medications that may have side effects
- Late diagnosis may delay recovery and adversely affect the prognosis
