



CUBAN LAST NAMES AND THEIR MEANINGS

ALFONSO

It is a surname of German origin that means someone noble and ready.



BASÍLIO

It means someone belonging to royalty, customarily used for people born into an upper-class family.

BLANCO

It is the Spanish word for the color white. Carlos Blanco is one of its famous name bearers.



DELFIN

It refers to the majestic creature "dolphin." Juan María Delfín and Remigio Delfín are some of the famous name bearers.

FERNÁNDEZ

It is a Spanish-origin surname that shares its meaning with the last name, Hernández. Fernández means a courageous voyager.



LÓPEZ

It means "son of Lope." It is derived from the Latin word lupus, meaning wolf. Steven López and Jennifer Lopez are some of its notable name bearers.

OBREGON

It is derived from the Portuguese word for work, "obraguem." Álvaro Obregón was the 46th President of Mexico.



SAAVEDRA

It is the last name of Galician origin, Saavedra, which means an ancient hall. José Daniel Ortega Saavedra is the serving president of Nicaragua.
