



Facts About HCG Level Changes And Miscarriage Risk

Low HCG levels in early pregnancy are associated with an increased risk of miscarriage.



Miscarriage may occur even after clinical recognition of pregnancy in case of low HCG levels.

During a miscarriage, the HCG levels fall below the expected level for the gestational age.



It may take a few days to six weeks to reach normal pre-pregnancy HCG levels after a miscarriage.

HCG injections can prevent miscarriages due to low HCG production and no other causes.
