Consider safety latches to prevent the baby from accessing drawers and cabinets.





Corner and edge bumpers can protect your infant from the sharp edges of furniture.

Childproof power outlet covers can protect your child from electric shocks.





Look for the safety straps or anchors that prevent the furniture from tipping.

Choose door knob covers to prevent the baby from accessing a room.





Consider finger pinch guards to make the doors at home baby-proof.

Ensure the baby-proofing products do not pose a choking threat to your little one.





Consider baby-proofing devices that are easy to install for adults but complex for the child.

Ensure the baby-proofing device is sturdy enough to resist a child's tugging.
