The first Egyptian pyramid was the Step Pyramid of Djoser, and the last was the Pyramid of Ahmose.

Most pyramids were built between 2575 and 2150 BC.



The pyramids have different dimensions and may have heights above 100 meters.

The Great Pyramid of Giza, the largest Egyptian pyramid in the world, is one of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World.



According to scientific estimates, it took 20,000 workers about 23 years to build the Great Pyramid of Giza.

The pyramid complex of Giza is guarded by the Sphinx (a lion with the head of a human).



Each pyramid is positioned such that each side of the structure's slopes faces each direction (East, West, North, and South).
