



# Fun And Interesting PEACOCK Facts



There are three species of peacocks, namely the Indian peacock and the Green peacock, native to areas of Southeast Asia, and the Congo peacock, native to the Congo Basin and the African continent.



Their feathers change color based on the angle at which light hits their body and the position of the pigment particles.



The Indian peacocks bathe with dust instead of water to prevent their feathers from getting heavy.



One-third of peacocks' calls are fake mating calls used to attract the peahens.



According to mythology, the "eyes" on the peacock's feathers can be traced back to when the Goddess Hera put the 100 eyes of Argos (a former prince) on the bird's wings in the prince's memory.
