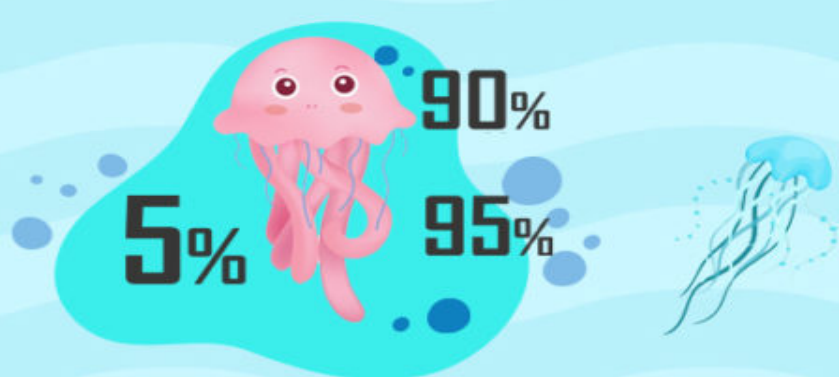

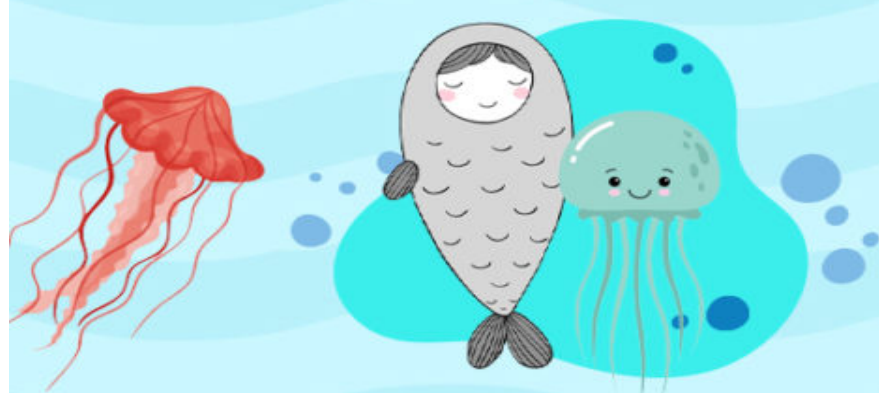
JELLYFISH



They are not real fish



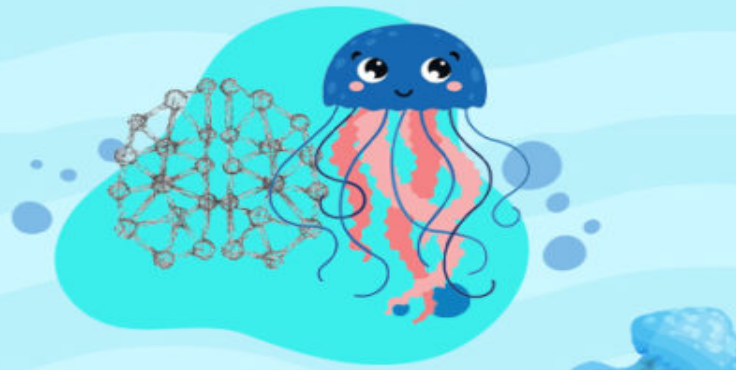
Their body is composed of 90–95% water and 5% solid matter
