

Ways To Determine Temporomandibular Joint Dysfunction



Clicking and popping joint sounds are present.

Pain in muscles that help to chew.



Rule out dental caries and other dental conditions causing pain.



Check for middle ear infection symptoms.



Look for eustachian tube functions and ear injuries.



Sinusitis, trigeminal neuralgia, and herpangina can cause facial pain.
