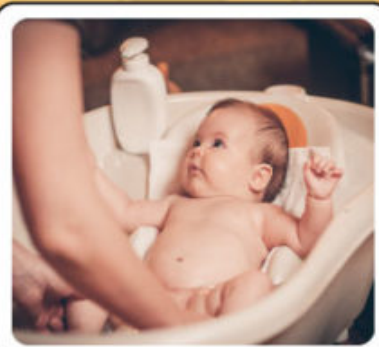


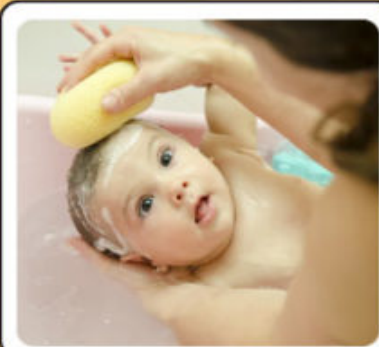


Tips To Follow When Bathing A Baby



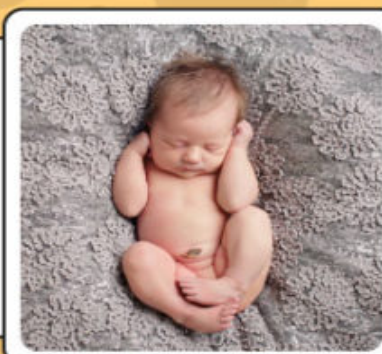
Ensure the room is warm enough for the baby.

Always start the bath by cleaning the face with a clean damp soft cloth.



Never use soap on a newborn's face unless your doctor advises otherwise.

Always avoid getting the umbilical cord portion wet in case of a newborn.



Never scrub the baby's skin, but only gently rub it with a moistened washcloth.

Shampoo the baby's hair at the end of the bath.



Wrap the baby in a towel before you begin to clean their hair.
