

Features To Consider When Buying A Balconette Bra

The cups should cover only the lower half of the breasts.

The cups should not cut into the skin, causing spillage.

There should be no gap between the band below your bust and your body.

There should be no gap between the bust and the top of the cups.



Ensure the straps are wide set.

Ensure the straps have a snug fit to provide adequate support and a lift.

The straps shouldn't cut into the shoulders.

The gore (the panel between the cups in the center) should lie flat against the skin.
