Stability

Durability

Look for shoes with sturdy outsoles and toe caps to withstand the hard floor of tennis courts.



Court Surface

Choose the shoes according to the type of court you plan to play on – hard floor, grass, or clay.



Playing Style

Opt for tennis shoes that facilitate lateral movements on the court.



Fit

Ensure to choose the right size that provides a snug fit without inhibiting the child's mobility.
