

Tips For Keeping A Pumice Stone Clean



Rinse the stone under flowing water to remove dead skin and dirt particles after each use.



Use liquid soap and a spare toothbrush to scrub the nooks and corners thoroughly.

Boil the pumice stone in hot water for 5-10 minutes for a deep cleanse.



Place the stone in a well-ventilated, moisture-free area to air-dry.

Avoid storing the pumice stone in the bathroom to prevent mold and mildew.



Do not share your pumice stone, even with family members, to maintain hygiene.
