

# Stepwise Process For Cleaning Juicers



Turn off and unplug the juicer, and separate the juicer from the pulp container.

Disassemble the removable parts, including the strainer, grinder, lid, and plunger.



Scrape out and empty the pulp and any juice residues from the containers.

Soak all the parts in a mixture of warm water and dishwashing liquid.



Gently scrub the parts with a soft sponge and soft-bristled brush.

Apply baking soda to clean any tough stains.



Rinse the parts thoroughly and allow them to air dry.

Wipe the juicer base with a wet cloth and dry it with a microfiber cloth or clean towel. Never put the base into the water since it contains an electric motor.



Reassemble all the parts of the juicer once all the components are dry.
