



# Tips To Take Care Of Your Hunting Boots



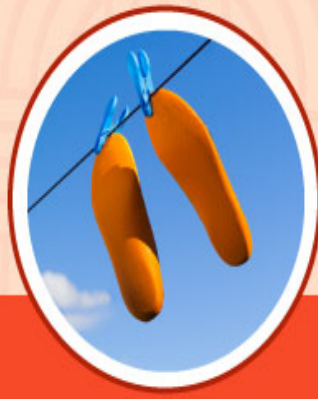
Use a nylon brush to remove loose dirt and mud.



Hand-wash your neoprene boots and air-dry them.



Hand-wash your synthetic boots with soapy water or baking soda.



Remove and dry the insoles separately to restrict mold growth.



Store the dried boots inside your home, away from damp areas.



When handling leather boots, wipe them clean with a damp cloth.



Condition the dried leather boots with a good quality leather conditioner.



Never store leather boots in direct sunlight or near flammable objects.
