

Things To Check When Buying A *Stroller Board*



Ensure the stroller board supports your child's weight.



Look for boards that are easy to install and store when not in use.

Ensure the board is made of durable and non-toxic material.



Select a board compatible with the stroller you have.

Choose a board with non-skid wheels that can withstand bumps or ride on uneven terrains.



Opt for a board that offers adequate room for your child's feet.
