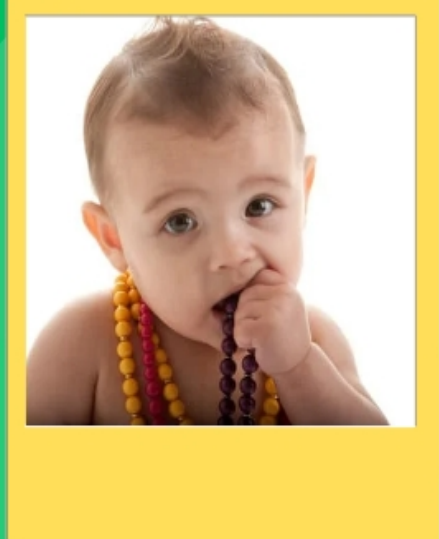


Safety Tips For Using A TEETHING NECKLACE



Avoid necklaces with tiny beads to reduce the risk of choking.



Check the beads' smoothness before giving the necklace to the baby.

Attach the necklace to the baby's clothes than the neck to prevent the risk of strangulation.



Never leave the baby unattended with the teething necklace.

Remove the necklace when the baby falls asleep while playing with it.



Inspect the beads and string for damage or cracks after each use.

Wash the necklace after each use to maintain hygiene.
