

What To Look For — In An — Antibacterial Soap For Eczema



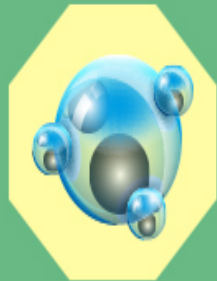
Natural ingredients such as aloe vera or tea tree oil.
