

Some women may have a heart-shaped uterus known as a bicornuate uterus, where the joined bumps give the appearance of a heart.



There may be two uteruses at times, a condition called uterus didelphys. Women with this condition can conceive without any hindrance and have two cervixes and vaginas.



The uterus may sometimes appear divided with a muscle wall called a septate uterus, which comes all the way down.



An arcuate uterus is a unique condition where there exists a shallow indentation at the top wall of the uterus.



The uterus is one such organ that develops another organ called the placenta during pregnancy.



Uterus transplantation is possible. It can enable women born without a uterus to get pregnant.
