



POINTS TO REMEMBER FOR SAFE USAGE OF AN AIR CONDITIONER IN YOUR BABY'S ROOM



Keep the temperature between 18 and 21 degrees Celsius. Below that may increase the risk of hypothermia.

Place your baby's crib away from the AC vents to prevent direct exposure to the cold air.



Clothe your baby appropriately when sleeping.

Set a timer to the AC to prevent overcooling.



Make sure your baby is not immediately taken to a warmer place from an air-conditioned room.

Ensure periodic maintenance of the AC to get rid of dust and trapped microbes.
