



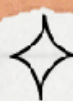
Points To Remember When Teaching Finger Painting



To Your Toddler



Put an apron on your child to prevent the colors from ruining their clothes.



Spread an old shower curtain in the painting area to prevent damage to the floor.



Keep dry and wet wipes nearby.



Stick the canvas or art paper on a table to prevent it from moving.



Use non-toxic paints.



Ask your child not to put their hands in their mouth during painting. Wash their hands immediately after painting.
