Interesting Photosynthesis Facts

Plants make glucose and oxygen from water and carbon dioxide in the presence of sunlight.

Plants synthesize starch and cellulose from glucose, and it can be stored.

Plants purify the air by absorbing carbon dioxide and releasing oxygen.

The color of plants may vary depending on the color of light absorbed.

Plants that are unable to photosynthesize require host plants for survival.
