



#### Plant-Related Arts & Crafts



Use different plant parts, such as leaves and twigs, to create a bird or anything they can imagine.

#### **Plant Fact Cards**

Write short, interesting facts about plants on small cards that the child can carry easily. You may use these cards to ask them questions and test their knowledge.



### **Role Play**



Have the children take up the role of a florist or gardener. This will encourage them to learn more about plants.

### Picture Game

Take printouts of the different plant parts and make them into flashcards. Play a quiz game and ask the child to identify the parts.



## Photo Garden



Have the children click pictures of any common or unique plant or tree in their surroundings.

This may open the door to learning something new and exploring the world of plants.

Have a little science experiment and gather the children around to build a mini garden or greenhouse to study the growth of the plants.
