



Check with your local authorities if undertaking the TRUST test is mandatory.

Check with local authorities if the drone needs to be registered with the FAA.

Fly the drone at or below 400 feet.

Always fly the drone within the visual line of sight.

Fly only during the daytime.

Avoid flying when foggy, through clouds, or in smoky conditions.

Avoid flying the drone over and above crowded and public places.

Do not cause any hazard to another person, property, or aircraft when flying.
