### Effective Strategies



Discuss your birth plan and risks with your doctor.

Get prompt and suitable antibiotic treatment during labor when tested positive for GBS.



Get treated for a UTI (caused due to group B strep) during pregnancy and labor.

Monitor your baby after delivery for any new symptoms and initiate breastfeeding.

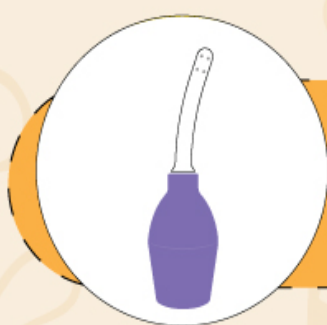


### Ineffective Strategies



Self-medication before labor without a doctor's approval.

Taking a vaccine or consuming antibiotics orally.



Using vaginal wipes or douching.

Postponing the treatment until the baby's birth.
