Strabismus may sometimes be a sign of other severe conditions such as retinoblastoma, tumor (intracranial pathology), or cerebral palsy.



Limited outward rotation of the eyes



Abnormal red reflex (reddish reflection of the eye)



Fussiness caused by headaches



Uncontrolled and repetitive side-to-side movement of the eyes (nystagmus)



Face turned to one side
