

STORK BITE BIRTHMARK

A stork bite is caused when a cluster of blood vessels underneath the skin dilate. It is a reddish or pinkish birthmark appearing on the lips, nose, forehead, neck, and eyelids. Stork bites may darken when the baby cries or the temperature rises.

Signs

- Pink or red patch
- Patch could disappear when pressed
- Doesn't grow or fade away
- Appears in a few months after birth



Natural Treatments

Applying olive oil or lemon juice



Using creams or ointments with vitamins A and E



Cold compress, two or three times a day
