

# Points To Remember When Using Electric Blankets



Follow the manufacturer's instructions for use and care.



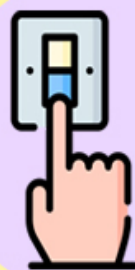
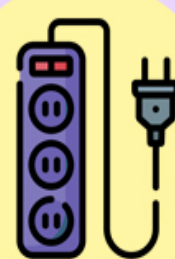
Don't use an electric blanket if it is damaged or has frayed cords.

Don't let pets or children play on or near the electric blanket.



Don't fold or bunch up the electric blanket when used, as it can damage the heating wires.

Don't use an extension cord with an electric blanket.



Don't leave an electric blanket on while you're not in the room or sleeping.

If the electric blanket is not working properly, stop using it and get it repaired or replaced.



If you're using an electric blanket over ten years old, consider replacing it, as older blankets may not be as safe as newer models.
