



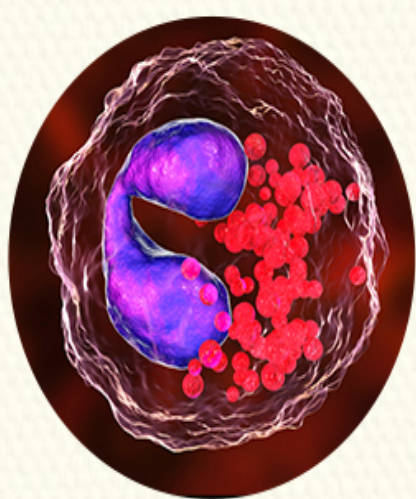
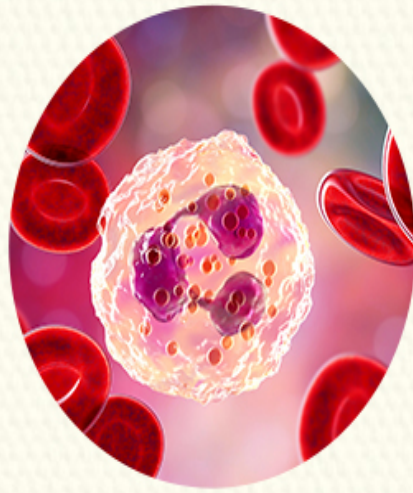
IMPLICATIONS OF HIGH WHITE BLOOD CELL DIFFERENTIAL COUNT IN PREGNANCY

Neutrophils

Condition: Neutrophilia

Indications during pregnancy:

Acute bacterial infection, Burns, Acute stress, Leukemia (blood cancer), Rheumatoid arthritis, Steroid use



Eosinophils

Condition: Eosinophilia

Indications during pregnancy:

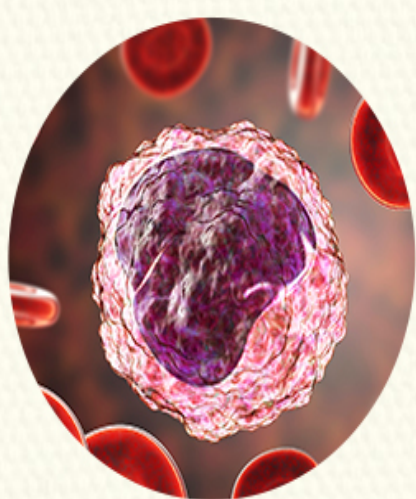
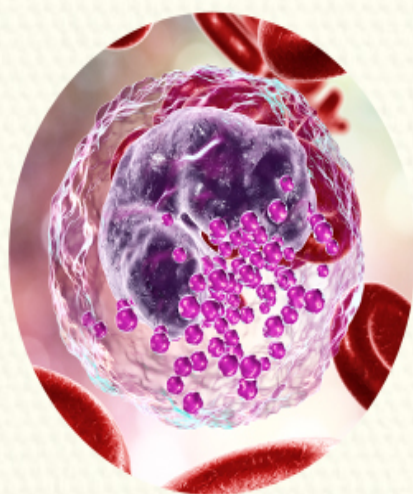
Allergic conditions, Parasitic infections, Leukemia, Polyarteritis nodosa (autoimmune disease)

Basophils

Condition: Basophilia

Indications during pregnancy:

Allergic conditions, Chronic myelogenous leukemia, Hodgkin's disease, Oral contraceptive usage



Monocytes

Condition: Monocytosis

Indications during pregnancy:

Chronic inflammation, Cushing's syndrome, Viral infection, Bacterial infections (tuberculosis)

Lymphocytes

Condition: Lymphocytosis

Indications during pregnancy:

Bacterial infection, Viral infections, Leukemias, Adrenal insufficiency
