



ULTRASOUND SCANS ADVISED FOR

Pregnant Women



Transabdominal ultrasound

Examines fetus' internal organs through the abdomen

Transvaginal ultrasound

Examines the woman's uterus, ovaries, tubes, cervix, and pelvic area using an ultrasound probe placed inside the vagina



Doppler ultrasound

Monitors the blood circulation in the blood vessels of the fetus



Three-dimensional (3D) ultrasound

Provides a rich image of the fetus by using an aggregated result of several two-dimensional pictures



Four-dimensional (4D) ultrasound

Helps in the real-time assessment of fetal face, grimacing, breathing movements, mouthing, and the limbs' direction
