

POINTS TO CONSIDER WHEN PAINTING PLASTIC TOYS



Test your paint on an unseen part of the figure before using it to verify if it's working well.



Before painting, clean the toy well with soapy water and let it dry thoroughly for better paint application.

If your toy contains moving parts, dismantle them carefully before painting to avoid sealing the joints with paint.



Start with a base coat. Use a black base coat for a dark-colored theme and a white base coat for a light-colored one.

To increase the durability of the paint, coat the surface with a clear spray or a sealer.
