And Ways To Use Them Safely

Baby walker types

Seated walker



- Suitable for babies who can sit and hold their heads steadily
- Includes a cushioned seat with leg holes

Sit-to-stand walker



- Can be used for sitting floor play and can be converted into a walker
- Grows with a baby to help in their assisted steps

Convertible walker



- Seated walker that can be turned into a sit-to-stand walker
- Can help the baby at multiple developmental stages

General safety tips for baby walkers



Check if the walker is properly fitted before letting the baby use it.

Keep a close eye on the baby's movements when using the walker.



Ensure the baby is in an enclosed space without access to stairs or gates.

Keep all furniture and potentially dangerous objects out of the baby's play area.
