Adverse Effects And Ways To Prevent Them



Unfavourable Consequences Of Bleach Test

- Exposure to bleach could trigger eye and skin irritation.
- You could be exposed to chlorine gas when bleach comes in contact with ammonia (present in the urine).
- Chlorine gas could cause adverse reactions such as breathing difficulties and chest pain.

Preventive Methods

- Know the correct method of performing the test.
- Consider wearing safety goggles and a mask to avoid inhaling fumes.
- Avoid skin contact with the bleach.
- Perform the test in a well-ventilated room.
