

LONG-TERM EFFECTS OF MOLLUSCUM CONTAGIOSUM

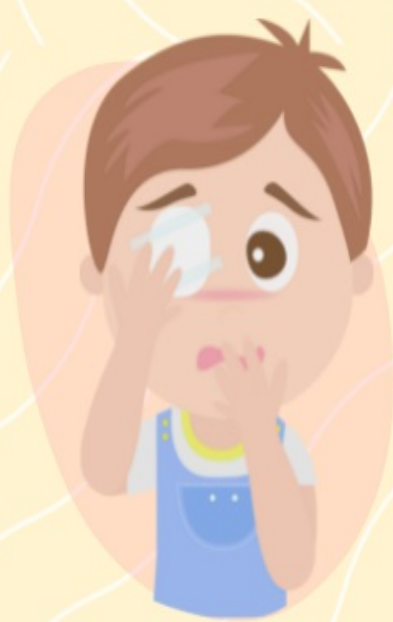


Skin lesions can become infected by bacteria requiring antibiotics

Scraping or scratching the lesions can lead to scarring



Secondary eye infections with eye pain and sensitivity may occur



Unhealed lesions can spread the disease to others



Recovery does not prevent future infections with the same virus
