



How To Identify — Gallstones In — — Children? —



Pain in the upper right abdomen



Radiating abdominal pain to the back or shoulders



Dyspeptic symptoms, such as indigestion, belching, and bloating



High-grade fever (38°C or 100°F or above)



Yellowing of the skin and whites of the eyes (jaundice)



Diarrhea or light-colored stools and tea-colored urine



Intense shivering and chills



Rapid heartbeat
