- Making sucking sounds

I am tired

- Disinterested in playing
- Yawning or staring at a distance





I need a break

- Squirming or kicking legs
- Avoiding eye contact



I want to play

- Smiling, making eye contact
- Smooth movements, trying to reach you/toys





I am unwell

- Not interested in feeding, sleeping, or activities
- Seeming uncomfortable or crying constantly
