

Interactions And Contraindications Of Adderall

Interactions

These substances may interfere with the function or absorption of Adderall in the body.



Acidifying agents such as **vitamin C** and fruit juices decrease the absorption of Adderall.



Drugs that acidify urine, such as **ammonium chloride**, increase the excretion of the drug, lowering its amount in the body.



Alkalinizing agents such as **sodium bicarbonate** and **antacids** increase Adderall absorption and should be avoided.



Some diuretics such as **acetazolamide** and **thiazides** also increase Adderall concentration in the body.

Contraindications

These underlying health conditions may make the administration of Adderall unsuitable.
